## Button Ferns Pellaena rotoundifolia and Lemon Button Fern Nephrolepis cordifolia Duffii



Button ferns are a delicate looking low to medium light fern. Their fronds are shiny button-shaped leaflets. These ferns do great in a terrarium or growing in the front of a mixed container as a filler. Button ferns do like humidity. Use a humidity tray or saucer filled with pebbles and water.

Do not have the plant sitting in water, just place it on top of the pebbles.

**Light:** Medium to low light. An east window would be perfect.

Water: Button ferns like to be moist but not soggy.

<u>Fertilizer:</u> Use a weak solution of liquid fertilizer once every two weeks.

**Repot:** Repot only if you haven't done it awhile or have never repotted it. Use a good houseplant potting mix with some worm casting in to give it natural nutrients.
