Chinese Evergreen Aglaonema

The Chinese Evergreen is one of the easiest houseplants to take of. With it's variegated leaves, it adds color to even the darkest corner. They are native of southeast Asia and were introduced to the U.S. in the 1900's. There are many variations of the silver and green leaf patterns in all the different varieties. This is a great choice for a commercial business because of their low maintenance. A perfect office plant.

Grow the Chinese Evergreen in low to medium light. A north or east window is ideal.

Do keep the plant away from a cold draft. They get dark spots on their leaves if they get to cold. A warm area is a must, 75-85* days and 65* nights.

Let them dry out between watering. They can rot very easily if they are kept to wet.

This is a wonderful beginner plant.
