Patty's Plants Sago Palm Cycas revoluta



Cycads are proof that there were

plants growing back in the dinosaur age. There have been fossils found of these plants with dinosaur bones over 100 million years ago. Our sago palms came from China. Now we can find them in most garden shops.

Sagos do best in medium light but they can take a brighter spot in the winter.

They do need a warmer area, no lower than 60* in the winter.

You must let this plant dry out completely between watering.

This is a very slow growing palm and can be grown as a Bonsai in a shallow container. Use a sandy soil mix when repotting this.
